



Thammasat University Announcement

Title: The Admission Application for Master of Science (M.Sc.) and Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in Integrative Medicine (International Program) Academic Year 2026

Thammasat University has authorized Chulabhorn International College of Medicine to select applicants for the Master of Science and Doctor of Philosophy in Integrative Medicine for the 2025 Academic Year. Details are as follows:

1. Available Programs for Admission

1.1 Master of Science in Integrative Medicine

1.1.1 Study Plan

Plan 1: Academic Plan

This plan focuses solely on a Thesis, which is equivalent to no fewer than 36 credits. The academic institution may require students to take additional non-credit courses or participate in other academic activities; however, students must achieve the performance standards specified by the institution.

1. Educational Background: Must hold a Bachelor's degree in Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Nursing, Thai Traditional Medicine, Physical Therapy, Applied Thai Traditional Medicine, Chinese Medicine, Science, or a related field from a university or institution accredited by the University Council.

2. GPA Requirement: Must have a cumulative GPA (GPAX) of no less than 2.75. Applicants with a GPAX lower than 2.75 must have at least 1 year of work experience in a related field.

3. International Students: Must meet the criteria specified in items 1 and 2. In cases where the applicant is a scholarship recipient, they must pass the selection criteria of the respective funding organization.

Coursework and Thesis The study plan consists of both coursework and a thesis. Applicant qualifications must comply with the Thammasat University Regulations on Graduate Studies, B.E. 2568 (2025), and meet the following specific requirements:

1. Educational Background: Must hold a Bachelor's degree in Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Nursing, Thai Traditional Medicine, Applied Thai Traditional Medicine, Chinese Medicine, Physical Therapy, Science, or a related field from a university or institution accredited by the University Council.

2. GPA Requirement: Must have a cumulative GPA (GPAX) of no less than 2.75. Applicants with a GPAX lower than 2.75 must have at least 1 year of work experience in a related field.

3. International Students: Must meet the criteria specified in items 1 and 2. In cases where the applicant is a scholarship recipient, they must pass the selection criteria of the respective funding organization.

4. Students enrolled in the Doctor of Philosophy in Integrative Medicine (International Program) at Chulabhorn International College of Medicine, Thammasat University, who fail the Qualifying Examination twice, are eligible to transfer to the Master's degree program. To receive the degree, the student must complete all coursework and thesis requirements according to the Master's degree curriculum structure.

1.1.2 Number of Admissions

1.2 Doctor of Philosophy in Integrative Medicine

1.2.1 Study Plans

Type 1: This plan emphasizes a thesis that generates new knowledge. The institution may require students to take additional non-credit courses or participate in other academic activities as needed.

1) For applicants holding a Master's degree or equivalent:

A. Must hold a Master's degree in Health Sciences, Science, or a related field from a domestic or international institution accredited by the University Council. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA (GPAX) of at least 3.00. Must have at least one (1) publication in a peer-reviewed academic journal or a full paper published in academic conference proceedings. Must provide documented evidence of at least one (1) year of work experience in a related field.

B. Must hold a Bachelor's degree in Medicine, Dentistry, or Pharmacy with a valid professional license, AND have completed a Master's degree, or have been awarded a Diploma/Certificate of Proficiency in medical, dental, or pharmaceutical specialties. Alternatively, applicants may hold an equivalent

qualification to a Master's degree from a domestic or international institution accredited by the University Council.

2) For Applicants Holding a Bachelor's Degree

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree in Science, Health Sciences, or a related field from a domestic or international institution accredited by the University Council, meeting the following criteria: GPA Requirement: Must have a cumulative GPA (GPAX) of at least 3.25. And, must meet at least one of the following requirements: At least one (1) publication in a peer-reviewed academic journal. At least one (1) full paper published in academic conference proceedings. At least one (1) petty patent (Utility Model) awarded. Must provide documented evidence of at least one (1) year of work experience in a related field.

3) For Applicants Currently Enrolled in a Master's Degree Program, this applies specifically to students in Plan 1 (Coursework and Thesis) of the Master of Science in Integrative Medicine (International Program) at Chulabhorn International College of Medicine, who must meet the following criteria:

A. Must hold a Bachelor's degree in Science, Health Sciences, or a related field from a domestic or international institution accredited by the University Council. Must have a cumulative undergraduate GPA (GPAX) of at least 3.25 OR have graduated with at least Second-Class Honors from their undergraduate institution.

B. Must be currently enrolled in the Master of Science in Integrative Medicine (International Program). Must have completed at least 22 credits of coursework. Must maintain a cumulative GPA (GPAX) for core/required courses of at least 3.25.

3.1.4 Send one (1) set of original documents (with applicant's signature confirming certified true copy) via postal service to Chulabhorn International College of Medicine, Thammasat University, Rangsit Campus, 99 Moo 18, Phaholyothin Road, Khlong Nueng, Khlong Luang, Pathum Thani, 12120, **by 10 April 2026. The program reserves the right to withdraw applicants if they fail to submit the required documents before the deadline. No refunds will be available.**

4. Required documents

4.1 Copy of citizen ID card or Passport

4.2 Copy of Degree Certificate or Letter of Degree Verification. For those who have not completed their study, a copy of a certified letter and transcript is required.

4.3 Official Transcript

4.4 English proficiency test results TOEFL, TU-GET or IELTS (valid from 2 years from the application date)

4.4.1 Applicants must have an English proficiency test score of TU-GET of at least 500, TOEFL (paper-based) at least 500, (internet-based) at least 61, or IELTS of at least 6.0. (valid for 2 years from the application date)

4.4.2 Applicants whose an English proficiency test score does not meet the criteria set above can be conditionally accepted to study with the following English score results: TU-GET of at least 400, TOEFL (paper-based) of at least 400, (internet-based) of at least 32, or IELTS of at least 4.5 (applicants have to submit an English proficiency test result which meets the criteria item 4.4.1 before sitting for their defense thesis)

4.4.3 Foreign applicants who studied overseas where English is considered to be the official language or studied in an English program and graduated within the past 2 years of application date, are exempt from English proficiency examination.

4.5 Applicants who apply for the Master of Science in Integrative Medicine, A2 plan need to submit a publication to an academic journal or provide a letter of recommendation which demonstrates specific experience in science or medical science.

4.6 Applicants who apply for the Doctor of Philosophy in Integrative Medicine, plan 1 need to submit a publication to in academic journal to be eligible.

4.7 Other documents

4.7.1 Applicants who have a minimum GPA of 2.5 need to submit a letter of recommendation or other documents demonstrating their work experience or provide a publication in an academic journal.

4.7.2 Applicants who do not meet the requirements can fill out the **GR-002 General Request** form for Graduate Committee consideration.

5. Criteria of Selection

5.1 Master of Science in Integrative Medicine

- 1) Applicants must pass both a written and oral examinations (interview).
- 2) Applicants must submit an English proficiency test score (TU-GET, TOEFL, or IELTS) that meets the admission criteria for Thammasat University's International Programs. The test result must be no more than 2 years old from the date of application.
- 3) Exemptions for English Proficiency Testing: The following applicants are exempt from submitting English test scores:
 - 3.1) International applicants from countries where English is an official language.
 - 3.2) Applicants who have graduated from an English program within 2 years prior to the date of application.
- 4) Any other terms and conditions shall be in accordance with the official graduate admissions announcements of Thammasat University and/or Chulabhorn International College of Medicine.

5.2 Doctor of Philosophy in Integrative Medicine

- 1) Applicants must pass both a written and oral examinations (interview).
- 2) Applicants must submit an English proficiency test score (TU-GET, TOEFL, or IELTS) that meets the admission criteria for Thammasat University's International Programs. The test result must be no more than 2 years old from the date of application.

3) Exemptions for English Proficiency Testing: The following applicants are exempt from submitting English test scores:

3.1) International applicants from countries where English is an official language.

3.2) Applicants who have graduated from an English program within 2 years prior to the date of application.

Required Documents for the Examination Day

1. You must present your original, valid (not expired) National ID Card, Passport, or any official government-issued ID that clearly displays your photograph and 13-digit national identification number. Only original copy documents will be accepted.

2. Any additional documents or materials as required by the examiners (if applicable).

Master of Science in Integrative Medicine

- Thai Students: 65,000 THB per semester (260,000 THB for the entire program)
- International Students: 80,000 THB per semester (320,000 THB for the entire program)

Doctor of Philosophy in Integrative Medicine

- Thai Students: 70,000 THB per semester (420,000 THB for the entire program)
- International Students: 85,000 THB per semester (510,000 THB for the entire program)

Note: The fees listed above do not include late registration penalties, student status maintenance fees, English proficiency examination fees, or the university's international student maintenance fee.
