Visiting Students

Students in their upper years of secondary education are eligible to perform observerships in conjunction with CICM Faculty depending upon availability. Students are required to complete the online application and submit it well in advance. We do not currently accommodate school groups greater than 2 individuals at a time. An interview and subsequent registration fee are required. Students should present their most recent vaccine records prior to their first day in the hospital. Observerships are solely to provide students with exposure to the healthcare field and are not required for admission to the medical program.
